Treasurer Report: The Treasurer's report was approved.

Membership Report: Paul Sattler moved and the Board approved six new individual members and four family members. There are now 778 paid members.

Facilities: Work on the bathroom tiles, kitchen, office and shelters was accomplished in March.

Shotgun Range: The Shotgun Range storage building has been moved closer to the 5-stand and a new safe has been procured.

Covid 19 Policies: As the Commonwealth-mandated covid restrictions are modified in the coming weeks and months the Chapter restrictions will be adapted to remain in compliance.

Lake/Conservation: Opening Day was a success, with 75 children participating along with their families.

Range Committee/E&T Committee: Incidents involving disregard of the Range Guest Policy were encountered at the Rifle-Pistol range in March. Paul Sattler moved a change to the Range Guest policy to specify procedures and penalties for violations of the policy. The motion was approved. Paul also moved Board approval to proceed with formation and implementation of the RSO Flying Squad program. The motion was approved. New Business: The Board informally approved proceeding with planning for a Chapter Swap Meet.
